All profits from LDS divisions will support the Region's entry in the JIRR and will help to maintain and extend the Region's fleet of development singles.

Entries, Fees and Substitutions

Will only be accepted via BR online.

Close of entries and Fee payment: 7pm on the Saturday before the event entered.

Close of Substitutions: 12 noon on the Friday before the event entered.

Telephone, e-mail and postal entries or fees will not be accepted.

No provision for late entry fees; no exceptions.

Northern Rowing Council Autumn Sculling Series 2010

The 2010 NRC Autumn Sculling Series comprises four Saturdays of racing spread over a six week period.

Each Saturday comprises one division restricted to sculling boats and a second division [independent SBH] which additionally includes pairs and fours.

Wansbeck LDS / SBH will only be open to Juniors.

Series awards will be for J18, Senior and Masters single scullers and for Junior quads.

LDS ADDITIONAL LOCAL RULES

All categories in 1x, 2x, 4x, 4x+, 8x+[Tyne only] Open, Women's or Mixed are offered.

Clubs should ensure that all competitors have clothing adequate to both the conditions and the length of time to be spent on the water.

Juniors will be encouraged to race as Juniors. To this end; a Junior may only race in a Senior category as part of a crew containing at least one Senior [or Master] sculler [not the cox].

Race numbers will be issued; one number per boat. All boats must have a bow-mounted slot to display the Race Number provided. No deposit will be required. However, the cost of replacement numbers will be reflected in future entry fees.

Individual LDS division prizes will be awarded, where 3 or more boats have started a class / category, as follows. Fastest 1x, 2x, 4x/x+, 8x+; Junior, Senior, Masters; Open, Women, plus Mixed 2x. Plus certificates / ribbons for J17/J16/J15/J14/J13

BR recommended handicap tables will be used to decide the result of masters categories and of the masters series.

All entries and payment of fees will be via BR online and will close 7pm on the Saturday before the event entered.

All substitutions will be made on OARA.

There will be no provision for late receipt of entries or fees.

Individual event entry fees are £7.50/seat for seniors & vets, £5/seat for juniors.

Event cancellations will be at the discretion of the Regatta Committee as soon as it is evident that the water is not rowable. This could therefore be during the days before or on the morning of the race as circumstances dictate. However; every effort will be made to allow the race to run thus making late decisions likely.

It is important that the Club contact number given with the entry is fully operational leading up to and on the day of the competition. So, not someone who has either gone on holiday or is driving and therefore can't answer a call.

In the event of cancellation; a refund of 50% of the entry fee will be made.

SERIES ADDITIONAL LOCAL RULES.

All finishing crews [sculling boats only] will score points for their Club in each division.

A simple points system will apply based on **Overall** finishing position of each crew.

One hundred points for first, one point for last. Points gained in composite crews will be split between clubs.

Overall series prizes will be awarded as follows, where at least three crews have competed in all rounds;

1x; Junior 18, Senior, Masters; Open & Women. All results to count.

4x; Junior 18, 17 & 16; Open & Women. All results to count.

4x+; Junior 15 & 14; Open & Women. All results to count.

In addition there will be Victor Ludora for the best Senior, Masters and Junior clubs. All of the series awards will be based on the points system detailed above.
