Terms and Conditions

1. In the event of the regatta being cancelled by the Race Committee either in part or in whole, the Committee reserves the right to refund up to 50% of entry fees to crews which have not raced.
2. The committee reserves the right to withdraw any event with fewer than 3 entries.
3. Entrants should indicate if they are not willing to be moved up in status in the event of insufficient entries in their preferred event.
4. Competitors must be at the start 5 minutes before the time of the race. Competitors will not be called for their races and the Starter will start all races without reference to absentees.
5. All competitors must produce a British Rowing racing licence on demand.
6. Clubs are reminded that it is their responsibility to insure equipment.
7. All boats must be fitted with slots for numbers on the bows.
8. Race control will be located at Tyne RC
9. Boating is expected to take place from Tyne RC, Tyne United RC and Newcastle University BC. Clubs will be advised of their boating location by the Committee
10. The draw will be made available at www.tyneregatta.org as soon as possible after the close of entries.
